Parent Feedback Survey December 2021



Introduction

In December 2021, Watoto Preschool carried out a survey of Parents/Carers. The survey was sent out at this time to try and gain an understanding of how Parents/Carers felt the Preschool was operating during the height of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The survey was created using Microsoft Forms which kept a record of the responses received. The link to this survey was sent to Parents/Carers via the Preschool Parent/Carers WhatsApp group, which through the pandemic, this has become one the key tools for communicating with Parent/Carers. The survey had a good response and the data received has been analysed and formatted into this report.

Summary

Thank you very much to Parents and Carers for completing the questionnaire and for your comments and responses about the preschool. We have compiled the results and are pleased to present them to you.

Overall, the responses to the questions within the survey were overwhelmingly positive. Parent/Carers are very satisfied with the quality of service we provide here at Watoto Preschool. We have highlighted below some of the responses we received and are very happy with:

What aspects of our Pre-School are you particularly pleased with?

1	72% of responses stated they knew what their child was learning within Preschool. 67% of responses stated they felt there was a wide range of activities for their children within Preschool. We want to get this number higher!	We created new resources available in leaflet format at the front entrance and on the Preschool website explaining what your child is learning within Preschool. We also have an upcoming project – a preschool blog – which will hopefully allow Parent/Carers a greater insight into what their child is learning within the Preschool.	
2	55% of the responses felt the preschool parent zone app is help. Across many of the questions and feedback the general response was that the Parent Zone app is not functioning in the way that you need. • "The app needs some improvements" • "Improve parent zone app" • "More updates on the app" • The app needs some improvements. When I make a payment, it takes a while to go onto it, so the finance section isn't always correct abs up to date" "Improve parent zone app. It doesn't work. Doesn't show finance option too. No regular updates or photos of child"	We need to investigate this a bit more to understand what the issues are. In the meantime, during the registration process more time will be spent on introducing the app to Parent/Carers and checking their understanding on how the app works.	


3	Parent/Carers have requested a secure pram shed.	Due to COVID the allocated space in the back shed for prams became off limits as part of the preschool COVID risk assessment, we shall keep this under review.
4	"That I can't enter the room in which my daughter plays and learns, it would be nice to see the environment. And also see which resource are used"	This term with the arrival of the Omicron variant we needed to delay our planned phasing in of parent and Carers accessing preschool again We will reassess again for the summer term.
5	"Prepare the kids for the big school"	Everything we do in preschool is working towards readiness for school.
6	 "I would like more regular updates on Parent Zone if possible." "Would love at least 1 photo per day of child. "I would like to see more of a learning journey and more active learning observations" 	Presently we add photos when the child has a 'wow moment'. This is when the child does something that the practitioners have rarely seen or haven't seen before that they think parent/carers would like to see. Although we would love to send out a photo a day to all parents/carers this would have a huge impact on the amount of time we spend with the children, therefore affecting their education. We currently add assessments on children termly and parents/carers should receive a notification to say they have received this.
7	73% of the responses rated 5 stars for 'I receive regular communication from preschool staff'. "More communication on what my child has/ is learning in nursery, which stories and songs you are singing also next step that we can work on with our children at home. We can mirror what learning takes place at nursery also at home."	Please see the response to number 1. We also utilize the termly newsletter, Facebook, and Instagram to share what and how children learn in preschool. Additional daily feedback from practitioners can be requested at pick up and drop off times. We also hold Parent/Carer meetings with your child's Key Person termly. In our latest newsletter (Spring Term 2022) we advertise the Home Learning activity packs that are in the pipeline. Children's learning is based on what children are interested in at any given moment. Therefore, we only plan children's learning to a certain extent - we are guided by the child. If Parent/Carers would like more information, please don't hesitate to ask your child's key person. Look out for Children's lending library. Parent Carers learning through play guide. More information on songs, books for each the term that the children will be engaged in.

To sum up..it's terrific to see so many positive comments from Parent/Carers regarding Watoto Pre-School and the results from this survey have given us much to celebrate. We will also be using the results and suggestions to further improve the preschool in the future so thank you so much to everyone who took the time to complete it.




Children's interests are considered in Pre-School




Do you know what your child is learning within pre-school?




I feel comfortable approaching Pre-School staff to talk about my child's needs




I feel happy approaching Pre-School staff for help and support




Staff keep me well informed of my child's progress




How would you rate the induction process that helped your child settle into Pre-School



I am happy with the quality of early learning and care my child receives





I receive regular communication from Pre-School staff



My child enjoys activities at preschool


The parent notice board is accessible and easy to understand



















The Management Committee members are approachable and helpful




The Pre-School 'ParentZone' app is helpful






What aspects of our Pre-School are you not pleased with?
